Historical Note:

G.R. Grubb & Company was founded in 1909 by George R. Grubb, Sr. The engraving company located at 116 N. Walnut St. in Champaign, Illinois had customers scattered throughout the Midwest especially in Chicago and St. Louis. Major clients included the *News-Gazette*, various regional high schools and universities including the University of Notre Dame and University of Illinois, Caterpillar, and publishers of medical textbooks. A family business, the company was run by George R. Grubb Sr., the founder and two of his sons George R. Grubb Jr., and Gordon L. Grubb.

In 1966, Printing Impressions Corporation was organized as an expansion of services into offset printing. Offset printing had begun to replace engraving in terms of volume and popularity. Printing Impressions Corporation was run by George A. Grubb (George R. Grubb Jr.'s son). The business was sold to the *News-Gazette* in 1988. G.R. Grubb & Company was dissolved in 1992.

Scope and Content Note:

The G.R Grubb & Company Records contains financial statements and reports, company policies and procedures, promotional materials, as well as a sampling of orders and works completed. The samples of work include organizations such as the *News-Gazette*; University of Illinois; Mercy Hospital; National Bank of Beardstown; Christie Clinic; National Council of Teachers of English; Burnham Hospital; Hoopeston Industrial Corporation; Hansvedt Engineering Inc.; and Archer Daniels Midland Co. among others.
