Provenance:

The Chanute Air Force Base Subject files were donated to the Champaign County Historical Archives from the defunct Chanute Air Force Base Museum upon their closure. These files were originally created and maintained by the History Office at the Chanute Air Force Base.

Historical Note:

Octave Chanute was a well-known engineer that focused on developing railroads in the United States. Later in life, Chanute would shift his focus and research to developing different gliders and ways to fly. While his own work is impressive, Chanute is also well-known for corresponding and advising the Wright Brothers on their goal of flight. The Chanute Air Force base was named in his honor after his death in 1917.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection mostly spans from the 1970s to early 2000s with the content being produced by the Chanute Air Force Base officials, historians, and community members of those affected by Chanute's work. There is also content created by Chanute's descendants and their involvement with the Chanute Air Force Base. It contains correspondence, publications, photographs, and blueprints related to Octave Chanute's life, family, and work.
