Provenance:

The Chanute Air Force Base Newspaper collection was donated to the Champaign County Historical Archives from the defunct Octave Chanute Aerospace Museum upon their closure in 2015. The Octave Chanute Aerospace Museum received these files from the Chanute Air Force Base after its closure in 1993.

Access:

The records are accessible to the public within applicable copyright restrictions and limited to use at the Champaign County Historical Archives at The Urbana Free Library.

Historical Note:

The Chanute Air Force Base was open for 75 years and operated as a training ground for generations of Air Force servicemen and women. Its long history through several military conflicts and influence as a Technical Training Center made it a well-researched subject. The Chanute Air Force Base created many publications, including these newspapers. The Chanute newspapers began with *The Chanute Field News and The Air Service Technical School Bulletin*, later being renamed *Chanute Field Wings*, followed by *Chanute This Week*, and ending with *The Pacesetter*.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection consists of Chanute base newspapers, including *The Chanute Field News and The Air Service Technical School Bulletin, Chanute Field Wings, Chanute This Week,* and *The Pacesetter.*

Related materials include microfilm versions of *The Chanute Field News* (1926) and *Chanute Field Wings* (May 1941-February 1943, February 1943-July 1945, August 1945-October 1949. Missing issues: October 1949-December 1950, and 1952-1973; some issues missing).

Arrangement:

This collection is organized into five series. The first four series are arranged chronologically. Series 5 is the special editions, which consist of three different newspapers that are arranged chronologically. Series 1 is *The Chanute Field News and The Air Service Technical School Bulletin* (1926), series 2 is *Chanute Field Wings* (1941-1972), series 3 is *Chanute This Week* (1972-1982) and series 4 is *The Pacesetter* (1983-1991). Each series is arranged in chronological order.
