Historical Note:

Calling cards were small, decorative cards (about the size of today's business cards) that individuals used to present themselves to others. These cards usually included the name of an individual and sometimes an address. A common practice in the 18th and 19th centuries, particularly amongst the upper class, individuals would leave a calling card when visiting someone's home or workplace, and sometimes short messages were written on the cards to specify the meaning of a visit. These cards became essential social accessories of the time and often served as status symbols.

Scope and Content Note:

The Calling Cards collection includes 57 calling cards of individuals from Champaign County and Illinois, giving insight into the social standards of the time in the area. Calling cards in this collection were owned by men, women, and married couples. Some individuals have more than one calling card in the collection.
