The records of the Champaign-Urbana Golden K Kiwanis were donated to the Champaign County Historical Archives in December 2007.

Biographical/Historical note:

On June 23, 1981, twenty-five men in their sixties and seventies became charter members of the Golden K Kiwanis Club of Champaign-Urbana. It was the first service club for older men in Champaign-Urbana. As a Kiwanis club, the Golden K supported local agencies, especially those serving children and families. Project funds for the support of these agencies came from the annual Peanut Days solicitations at businesses in Champaign, and from member contributions. From the founding of the club until early in 2006, members attended weekly meetings between two and three p.m., at the Stevick Center. With the loss of several officers and declining membership, the club voted to disband late in 2005.

Scope and Content note:

The records of the Champaign-Urbana Golden K Kiwanis Club document the club's extensive tradition of funding community organizations, especially those engaged in service to families, the elderly, and children. Additional files document the club's other membership activities and programs.
