### **Biographical Note:**

Born May 2, 1929, Joan Severns (née Zagar) served as Mayor of Champaign from 1979 to 1983 and served as a City Councilwoman from 1973 to 1979. She was the first woman mayor in downstate Illinois. Born in Chicago to John and Alice Barnhart Zagar, she earned a bachelor's and master's degree in political science from the University of Illinois. She also earned a liberal arts degree at DePaul University. She was a member of the League of Women Voters, Phi Kappa Phi, and Alpha Omicron Pi. She was a past president of the Conservation and Preservation Society and a treasurer for life for the ALCU. With her husband John Severns, whom she married on June 22, 1952, she raised two daughters and a son. Severns died on August 29, 2003, at the age of 75.

### **Scope and Content Note:**

The Joan Severns Papers date from 1950 to 2010, with the bulk of the collection ranging between 1973 - 1983. It mainly covers her political career as Champaign Mayor and City Councilwoman. The collection includes photographs, commemorative certificates, mayoral papers covering campaigns, and papers written by Severns on the politics in Illinois and the University of Illinois.
