Biographical Note:

Clyde O. McKinney was born September 9, 1920, in Calhoun, Richland County, Illinois, to Flaud and Stella (Wright) McKinney. He graduated from high school in Clinton, IL. On October 20, 1942, he enlisted in the Navy and served as a Seabee in the Pacific Theater, operating heavy equipment. He was discharged on December 18, 1945.

McKinney married Nadine Sterchi on May 18, 1947. He attended Eastern Illinois University and graduated with a degree in Industrial Arts. He earned a master's degree in Industrial Technology from Oregon State University. Afterward, he worked for Haliburton Services. He started teaching for ABL Community School District (Allerton-Broadlands-Longview) in 1953. There he taught Industrial Arts and Driver Education for 37 years.

He died February 11, 2009, at the age of 88, at his home in Longview, Champaign County, Illinois. He was buried in Jordan Cemetery, Fairland, Douglas County, Illinois, with full military rites.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains letters from friends and family to Clyde McKinney while serving as a Navy Seabee during World War II. The letters range from 1944-1945 and are newsy accounts about life on the home front during the war's final years. Some highlights include the joy expressed at V-J day as friends and family revel at the end of the war and the possibility of McKinney coming home soon.
