Historical Note:

The Woman's Club of Champaign-Urbana (WCCU) was founded December 7, 1897, and was in operation until it voted to disbanded in February 2020. The club held its last meeting June 2020. Over its 120 years of service, the club was very active in the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC) at the county, state, and national levels.

Like many of the other women's clubs formed in the late-1800s, the Woman's Club of Champaign-Urbana was mainly a social club that focused on liberal arts such as history and literature. Their early yearbooks listed Household Economics, Education, Philanthropy, Literature, Art, Music, and the Drama as the standing departments. Club members developed study programs, presentations, and performances for each meeting. The 1906 yearbook shows that members presented cooking demonstrations, discussed Shakespeare's plays, researched child labor and state corrective institutions.

The Woman's Club of Champaign-Urbana spawned additional women's groups such as the Champaign Woman's Club (May 1924), Champaign-Urbana Junior Woman's Club (1931), the Community Woman's Club (1957), and Past President's Club (1962).

Service orientated the club donated thousands of dollars and hours to the local community providing books, clothing, food, and money to the Crisis Nursery, Women's Connection, Eastern Illinois Foodbank, Healthy Beginnings, South Side School, local nursing homes, etc. The club also had a special connection to the Illiana Veterans Home in Danville, escorting patients to Sunday services, hosting birthday parties, and organizing outings.

The club's final president, Judy Farney, sums up the club experience, "[o]f course, the biggest benefit of belonging to the GFWC-WCCU was meeting all the wonderful women."
