The Music Club was first organized in March 1958 by Ellen Handler, Marvin Metzger, Doris, and Tom Read. The club's purpose was to give "amateur musicians of no high ability an opportunity to perform good music for an interested but not-too-critical audience." (Music Club bylaws 1958). A purpose reflected in the club's first name, The Little Talent Music Club. The name changed to The Music Club in 1966. The club adopted a seasonal calendar performing fall through spring with summers off. Meetings were often held on Sunday evenings prompting some members to refer to the group as the Sunday Evening Music Club.
