Historical Note:

Dyer & Uggerby Architects was an architectural firm founded in 1960 by Donald Dyer and Ove Uggerby. Originally located at 207 South Locust, the firm eventually moved to 216 North First Street.

The firm worked on a large number of residential and commercial projects including: Beaumont Small Animal Clinic, Sunnycrest Shopping Center, Windsor Swim Club, Springfield Electric Lighting Center, numerous IGA stores, among others.

Later, the firm added two more partners and became Smith, Dyer, Uggerby & LeGrand. In 1985, Dyer left the firm to work for Carle Hospital's Engineering and Maintenance department.

Ove Uggerby died May 18, 1993. Donald Dyer died on December 4, 2012.
