Biographical Note:

Mary Ellen Hill Long was born on June 12, 1914 in Maroa, Illinois to Clarence J. and Vera (Wikoff) Hill. She graduated Decatur High School in May 1932. Mary Ellen married Melvin Long in Decatur, Illinois on June 7, 1943. Together, they had two daughters and one son: Mary Kathryn, Patricia Ann, and Melvin George Jr. Mary Ellen was a member of Delta Theta Tau sorority, taking a Pullman train trip across the country to attend the Delta Theta Tau San Francisco Convention in 1939. She was also a member of Holy Cross Church, Altar and Rosary Society, Mother's Club, and Catholic Woman's League. Mary Ellen Long moved from Decatur to Champaign where she lived for 15 years before passing away at age 43 on May 15, 1958.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection includes diary entries about Mary Ellen's train trip on a Pullman to the Delta Theta Tau San Francisco Convention in 1939. On her way to and from the convention, she was able to stop and visit Denver, Colorado; Colorado Springs, Colorado; Salt Lake City, Utah; Los Angeles, California; San Francisco, California; Portland, Oregon; Seattle, Washington; Billings, Montana; and Red Lodge, Montana. She detailed her whole experience – what she saw, what she ate, and who she spent her time with. She even included personal photographs within the diary entries to supplement her writing. In addition to the diary entries are programs, dinner menus, and other ephemera from the trip. Also included in the collection are greeting cards that Mary Ellen and Melvin Long sent to one another. One copy of the Decatur High School newspaper titled *The Observer* is also included, listing Mary Ellen as a graduating senior in May of 1932.
