The East Central Illinois Area Agency on Aging (ECIAAA) is a non-profit organization that was founded in 1972. It was authorized under the federal Older Americans Act and the Illinois Act on Aging to plan and administer services for older adults, grandparents, and persons with disabilities. The ECIAAA serves 16 counties in east central Illinois: Champaign, Clark, Coles, Cumberland, Dewitt, Douglas, Edgar, Ford, Iroquois, Livingston, Macon, McClean, Moultrie, Piatt, Shelby, and Vermilion. As of today (2023), the ECIAAA is still operating. It provides services such as adult day services, adult protective services, benefit access, caregiver advisors, comprehensive care coordination, congregate meals, disability services, home delivered meals, legal services, long term care Ombudsman, respite services, senior health insurance program, transportation, coordinated point of entry/senior information services, and more. Its headquarters is located in Bloomington, Illinois.

Scope and Content Note:

The East Central Illinois Area Agency on Aging records include public information documents such as proposed Area Plans on Aging from 1999-2004 in addition to proposed amendments to Area Plans on Aging from 1994-2004.
