Biographical Note:

Mary Clemons (1910-1992) was born in Marion, Illinois on February 18, 1910, to John Robert and Edith Caroline Grant Crenshaw. Mary Clemons served as the personal secretary to seventeen commanders at Chanute Air Force Base over the course of thirty-three years, retiring at the age of sixty in 1970. She maintained a personal interest in Chanute Air Force Base after her retirement, keeping materials from her own records and photographs as well as collecting news about the base and keeping in touch with those she had worked with. She died on October 13 1992.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains records, photographs, newspaper clippings, ephemera, postcards, magazines, issues of the Rantoul Guide and Directory, and correspondence between Mary Clemons and various Chanute Air Force Base personnel. Included are a considerable number of photographs documenting both work and casual daily life among personnel. Of significance are the quantity of awards and commendations Mary Clemons received in her time working at the base, as well as her military ID and a commemorative Chanute Air Force Base 50th anniversary coin.

Arrangement:

This collection is arranged into 4 series. Series 1 contains Mary Clemons' personal records, photographs, and scrapbook materials arranged chronologically. Series 2 contains general and individual folders of Chanute Air Force Base personnel organized alphabetically by last name. Series 3 contains materials arranged chronologically concerning Chanute Air Force Base itself, the Octave Chanute Aerospace Museum, Rantoul Guide and Directory highlighting the base, and materials from the University of Illinois concerning the base and its personnel. Series 4 contains oversized materials house in box #2.
