Historical Note:

The Illinois Heritage Association (IHA) was an organization that sought to recognize and preserve the heritage and history of the state of Illinois. They provided services, such as consultations and workshops, to Illinois cultural institutions. Furthermore, the IHA housed an extensive collection of practical and technical information about various topics of interest to cultural institutions. This included: information about administration, development of collections, preservation and care of materials, historic research, and others. As another resource for institutions, the IHA published a bi-monthly newsletter that included a technical insert. Each issue of the newsletter sought to provide information about IHA initiatives as well as state and national events that might benefit the goal of preserving and promoting the history of Illinois.

In 1984, the IHA published a book in observance of the Champaign County Sesquicentennial. From the preface of the book: "this historical account gives a chronological overview of the people, institutions, and events which have shaped the development of Champaign County over the last 150 years."

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains the photographs, documents, and certificates that appear in *A Commemorative History of Champaign County*.

Subjects are listed as they appear in the Local History Online catalog for consistency. As a result, there may be differences between what is listed in the finding aid and what is listed in the book.

Arrangement:

The collection is arranged into four series by subject: General Photographs, People and Family Photographs, Multi Subject Photographs, and Non-photographic Materials.
