Historical Note:

The Uniting Pride Center (UP Center) was founded in 2009 to advocate for the equality, visibility, and wellness of the LGBTQ+ communities in Champaign County. The UP Center has actively engaged the local community through support groups, social events, workshops, advocacy, and resources. Their mission is to create a Champaign County where all who identify as a sexual and/or gender minority can live full, healthy, and vibrant lives. The UP Center was founded by Kevin Bowersox-Johnson along with Megan Paceley, Phil Reese, and Kris Koester as the initial board members.

Since its foundation, some initiatives of the UP Center have included the Champaign-Urbana Pride Festival, which was first held in 2010; Wise UP, an educational series of workshops hosted at The Urbana Free Library; the LGBTQ+ Film Festival, in partnership with the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign; and the Turn it UP! Benefit Concert and Variety Show. They have partnered with other local organizations such as Champaign Urbana Theatre Company, Celebration Company at the Station Theatre, Derby Girls, and Acorn Equality Fund to bring events and resources to the Champaign County community. The UP Center has also worked with national organizations such as the Trevor Project and the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force through attendance at the National Conference on LGBT Equality.

This collection contains posters, programs, flyers, newspaper articles, awards, correspondence, and ephemera documenting the UP Center's involvement in the Champaign County community.
