Biographical/Historical Note:

Jean Annette (Fox) Burkholder, an active Urbana School Board member and social rights activist, was born on July 23, 1929 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Her interest in social activism and education stems from her mother, who was very active in community issues and taught the importance of democratic discussion in society. In a 1997 Urbana Schools newsletter article, Jean explains her mother was very active in encouraging realty companies to oppose "white flight" from Philadelphia neighborhoods. In the 1950s, she helped create a limitation on the number of houses that realtors could sell in a given amount of time, which was one of the first of its kind. Jean's mother, who worked as a secretary during the day and attended college courses at night, was deeply involved with education and community organizations in Philadelphia. She was elected Vice President of the Home and School Council of Philadelphia, an organization that trained discussion leaders to organize study groups for mothers, and encouraged them to support their children's education and attendance in school.

Jean Burkholder graduated from the Philadelphia High School for Girls in 1947. In 1950, she received her Bachelor of Arts in sociology and social psychology from Earlham College (a small, predominantly Quaker school in Richmond, Indiana). She focused her studies on the ways in which education and individuals can change society, and took classes in anthropology, sociology of minorities, educational psychology, community organization, and race relations. Shortly after her marriage to Donald Burkholder in 1950, the Burkholders moved to the University of Wisconsin-Madison, becoming graduate students in sociology. Jean worked as a graduate teaching assistant in the Child Development Lab School, and specialized in social psychology including marriage and family, social disorganization, interdependence of personality and culture, personality development, and attitude change. She studied for two years, until she became pregnant with the first of three children in 1952. After spending a few years at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill while Donald Burkholder worked on his doctorate in mathematical statistics, the Burkholders and their two children, Kathleen (b. 1953) and Peter (b. 1954), moved to Urbana, Illinois in August of 1955. Their third child, William, was born in 1963. Don received a job in the Mathematics Department at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, where he worked as a professor and professor emeritus until his retirement in 1998.

In 1956, Jean Burkholder began volunteering for the Council for Community Integration, initiating her lifelong involvement in Urbana community organizations including those that focused on the needs of children and youth, segregation and integration, education, and housing and urban planning. She chaired the Neighborhood Services Committee from 1966-1968, served on the Housing and Executive Committees of the Council for Community Integration, and became co-chairman of the Champaign County League of Women Voters Housing Committee. In the latter role, she worked to increase low income housing, promoted housing integration and social services, encouraged voting, and helped facilitate urban renewal in Champaign County. In 1968, she became the first chairman of the Urbana Human Relations Commission and worked to build community and lessen the gaps between social and racial groups.

Jean joined the Urbana Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) in 1959 and worked on a referendum campaign. Following this, she became very active in Urbana Schools. In 1971, she became President of the Council of Parent-Teacher-Student Associations of Urbana (PTSA), chaired the PTA Human Relations and Mental Health Committee, and was a chairman of the Superintendent Selection Advisory Committee to Urbana Schools. She served on the Urbana School Board from 1975-1997, and was elected school board president for 5 years. During her time at the school board, she helped create the Peer Mediation and Peaceable Schools programs, taught a variety of teacher in-service day classes and workshops, and supported discussion on discipline, rights and responsibilities, and child self-esteem. In addition to her involvement with Urbana Schools, Jean became interested in Youth Services. From 1978-1981, she co-chaired the Champaign County Youth Services Consortium, an organization that brought together representatives from more than 25 youth serving agencies across Champaign County. Jean served on a variety of advisory committees, including the Champaign County Task Force for the White House Conference on Children and Youth in 1970, and was chosen as a state delegate in 1980.

In addition to her activism work, Jean was very interested in the study of Adlerian and Individual Psychology. She attended numerous workshops at the Adler Institute of Chicago and attended North American Society of Adlerian Psychology (NASAP) annual conventions on a regular basis. She was interested in problem solving counseling, and led numerous parent discussions and classes on discipline, parent effectiveness training, and family problem solving as a study group leader with the Champaign Family Education Association. In 1969, on her husband's year-long sabbatical in London, Jean fostered a first grader who had dropped out of school, and used the Adlerian Child Guidance Center and its principles on individual education to teach him how to read.

Over the years, Jean has won many awards for her hard work and service. She received the 1984 Public Citizen of the Year award from the Illini District of the National Association of Social Workers, the 1985 Junior League of Champaign-Urbana Award, the 1991 State Board of Education "Those Who Excel" Award, and an Honorary Life Membership from the National Congress of Parents and Teachers in 1997. Jean retired from the Urbana School Board in 1997, and the Urbana district's administration center was renamed the Jean F. Burkholder Administrative Service Center in her honor.

Scope and Content Note:

The Jean Burkholder Collection (1951-2006) includes school board administrative records, correspondence and personal notes, campaign materials, organization records, workshop and class materials, VHS and cassette

This series is arranged chronologically by subject type.

Series 2: Community Organizations consists of materials on a variety of Champaign County and Illinois organizations including the African American History Committee of Champaign County, Council for Community Integration (CCI), Family Education Association (FEA), League of Women Voters (LWV) of Champaign County, West Urbana Neighborhood Association (WUNA), Youth Services Consortium (YSC), and various others. This series is arranged alphabetically by organization.

Series 3: Adlerian Psychology and Educational Materials consists of Adlerian publications, materials from conventions and lectures, membership information, newsletters from the Adler Institute of Chicago and the North American Society of Adlerian Psychology (NASAP), Individual Education bulletins and materials, and materials on a variety of educational theories and techniques. This series is divided into three subjects: 1. Adlerian Psychology, 2. Education Articles and Publications, and 3. Materials on Education Techniques and Theories. The Adlerian Psychology subject is arranged chronologically, while the educational publications and educational techniques are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Series 4: Personal consists of Jean Burkholder's awards, correspondence, school papers, presentations and speeches, bibliography and writings, subject files, and notebooks. This series is arranged chronologically with undated materials at the end.

Series 5: Audiovisual Materials consists of VHS and audio cassette tapes of the 1997 Urbana High School choirs, Burkholder's school board campaign interviews, Urbana school closing hearings, UEA-HRC sessions, NASAP conventions, and Burkholder's class lectures and writings. This series is arranged alphabetically by tape title.
